

INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS

The ILC maintains modern computer systems both for internal efficiency and to ensure effective communication with other organisations and client groups. The ILC has developed several information management tools that assist the ILC to undertake its functions as well as for administrative purposes. All staff receive ongoing training in the use of the ILC's computer systems.

The ILC implemented new property and financial information systems to better use current software technologies to deliver information to staff.

The ILC also provides a Geographic Information System (GIS) facility to assist staff and the Board in their land management, acquisition and strategic planning operations. Improving the extent and currency of the spatial data sets has again been a priority.
