### List of Consultants

The ILC engages consultants on the same basis as it procures all goods and services.

During the year, the ILC continued to contract a number of consultants for the performance of specialist professional services and where the ILC requires an independent review or evaluation. The total spend on consultants was \$1.109m (GST exclusive). It is expected that this practice will continue.

Twenty-nine new consultancy contracts were entered into, involving total actual expenditure of \$374,563. In addition, eighty-six ongoing consultancy contracts were active, involving actual expenditure of \$715,682.

*Panel* – An arrangement under which a number of suppliers are selected through a single procurement and evaluation process.
